Congratulations to Jean Charpentier! Jean won our November door prize - a table runner kit. Your name could be drawn next!

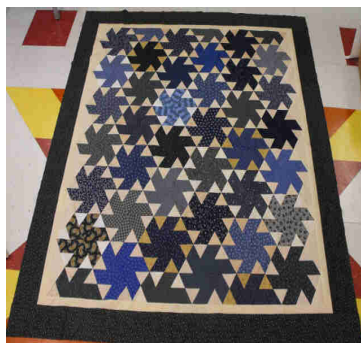


Folded Ornaments \$15

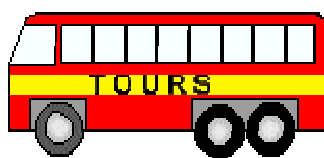
Learn different methods for construction flying goose

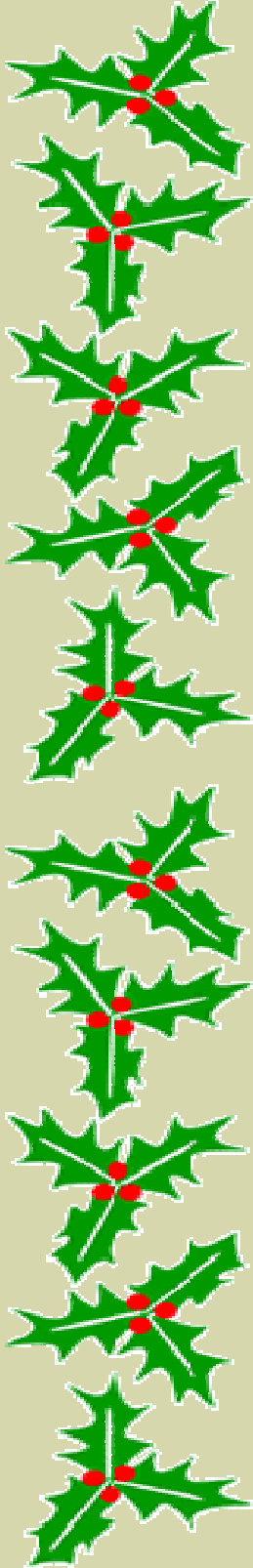
